INFRASTRUCTURE

Important notes:

Bus traffic in Trakai Old Town (Trakų St. and parts of Karaimų St.) is prohibited.
Part of Karaimų St. is closed to light vehicle traffic.

Other amenities:

Electric car charging stations – available in all parking lots and petrol stations.
Public toilets (both free and paid) – available in all parking areas.
